Old Business:

Year End Banquet – There may be an extra charge for cleaning as we didn't do everything exactly as they had wanted in regards to clean up. We enjoyed the venue – it was spacious and we will probably go there again.

Casino – Casino went well – thank you to everyone who helped out.

Hoodies/T-Shirts – Will continue to discuss this. Janine will get info to Deb in regards to pricing for a Christmas order – Deb will see if we can get enough orders for a Christmas order.

Metal Container – Will contact Dave/Lisa Bendfeld to see where things are at with this. United Rentals is interested in assisting the BMX club throughout the year as well – we will further explore this.

New Business:

Trailer for soil tack – John is interested in purchasing a trailer to haul the soil tack on – it is \$300 from Princess Auto. We will wait and look in to this in the spring when we need it and have the space to store it. We would also need to buy more soil tack from Nanton – hopefully in the bags like we had before.

Alberta BMX AGM – This is coming up on Nov. 21/22. John and Darren will be at this event. Usually Lethbridge BMX pays for John to attend this however this year Alberta BMX is paying for John. If another executive member would like to attend this event then Lethbridge BMX would cover the costs. Let John and Deb know if you are interested.

Casino in 2018 – We have a casino booked for either October, November, or December 2018. We are assigned a date by a computerized random draw in May of 2018.

Added Business:

Training Camps – Ken Cools and Supercamp are the big training camps that have hit Alberta. Greg Hill does do some Camps and he is willing to do a training camp in Lethbridge. Minimum 20 kids and Maximum 30 kids – approximately \$150 - \$200 US Dollars for 2 days training. He suggested forwarding him 3 sets of dates and he agreed to come and run a camp. Deb made a motion that we approach Greg Hill and arrange a training camp for next summer. Sherri approved – Cory seconded and all approved.

Dryland Training – Chris F and Deb W ran dryland training tonight. They had 26 participants and some parents watching. It was a fabulous turnout. This is booked for every Wednesday and has been kindly sponsored by an anonymous club member.

Corporate Initiates Program – Mayor Spearman saw our second last provincial – he attended it and recorded some of it. He has informed Sherri about the Corporate Initiates Program which will have a lot of money to go to local clubs – We would need to go to City hall and find out what it is about as it is just being set up. We would then need as many club members as we could have at one of their meetings to present our plans for expansion. If we knew an amount that would be available through this then we could put together a plan of what we could use the money for. Sherry will look in to this further. Darren also received an email to Lethbridge BMX which sounds like it could possibly be the same information/opportunity. A meeting is being held at City Hall next Tuesday – Deb and Darren will attend this event – anyone else who is interested may attend it is an open event.
