### **Old Business**

### **New Business**

Gate Install Dates – Planning to get the gate installed. Working around weather and racing, etc. After racing this Thursday we are going to take the old gate out and Friday morning the concrete pad will be poured for the new gate – then we should be able to install the new gate on Sunday.

Alternative to Soil Tac (Eco-Haul) – Company out of Calgary sent an email in regards to a new product called Eco-Haul which is a type of Soil Tac for the track. Darren is waiting to hear back about a price of the product – we will see what the product is like when we go to the Cochrane provincial as they already have it on their track.

### **Additions & Deletions**

Bingo – Matt presented the option of working Bingos as a fundraiser. There are options of working 4, 12 or 24 bingos in a year. The example of their swim club doing bingos results in about \$1,000 per bingo. Conversation about this is that during the BMX season may be easier to get volunteers as everyone is at the track BUT we are always busy with BMX. In the winter people are not busy with BMX but are not around to do the volunteering. The Bingo facility does have people available that they will pay \$50 to work/fill in some of the mandatory volunteer positions for working the Bingo. Another example is that the swim club does offer an incentive to the volunteers that work – a reimbursement to club fees, etc. Darren will put a poll out to the BMX community to see who would be interested in volunteering.

Timers – Would be nice to have laser timers that would be more effective for tracking riders. Matt will chat to the staff at runners soul to find out about the product they used for the kids marathon. John and Cory will also look online.
