



## 2020 Season Opening

We finally have approval to start opening the club on a limited basis. There are restrictions in place and it won't be anything like a normal season. Listed below are the restrictions:

- Currently there is no racing
- Currently there is no coaching
- All members MUST have proof of license and membership before entering the track
- No one-time tryouts
- No concession
- No bathrooms
- No loaner equipment
- Track time will be on a reservation basis only and will be limited in numbers
- No one other than one executive allowed in the moto shed
- No congregating in groups on the track, in staging, etc. Social distancing must be maintained at all times

Now with the good news...we can finally ride the track. Here is what you need to do:

- Purchase your license and membership ([www.zone4.ca](http://www.zone4.ca))
- Complete and sign [this waiver \(under 18\)](#) or [this waiver \(over 18\)](#) and bring it to the track
- Book a one hour time slot ([online reservations](#))
- Book one slot for each person in your group (1 parent + 1 rider = 2 spots)
- To enable the most use for riders do not bring extra members of your family or friends that will take up a spot
- If family and friends remain in the parking lot (and socially distanced in the parking lot) that does not count as a used spot. Only people inside the compound count as a spot.
- Until we have a better feel for numbers please limit your bookings to no more than 3 hours a week
- You will need to bring your own sanitizing equipment to the track
- We will be following the AHS recommendations so if you have ANY symptoms associated with COVID-19 do not come to the track
- We will open the track for the usual hours Mon-Thu and Sat-Sun
- Remember no bathrooms, loaner equipment or concession. Please come prepared for that.
- If your time slot is canceled due to weather or you can't make it you will lose that slot, there will be no make-ups
- You must enter at the West gate and leave at the South gate
- You must follow the direction of the executive/volunteer in charge
- You will be asked to start preparing to finish your session 10-15 minutes before the next session. You will be asked to clean/sanitize anything you may have touched during your time
